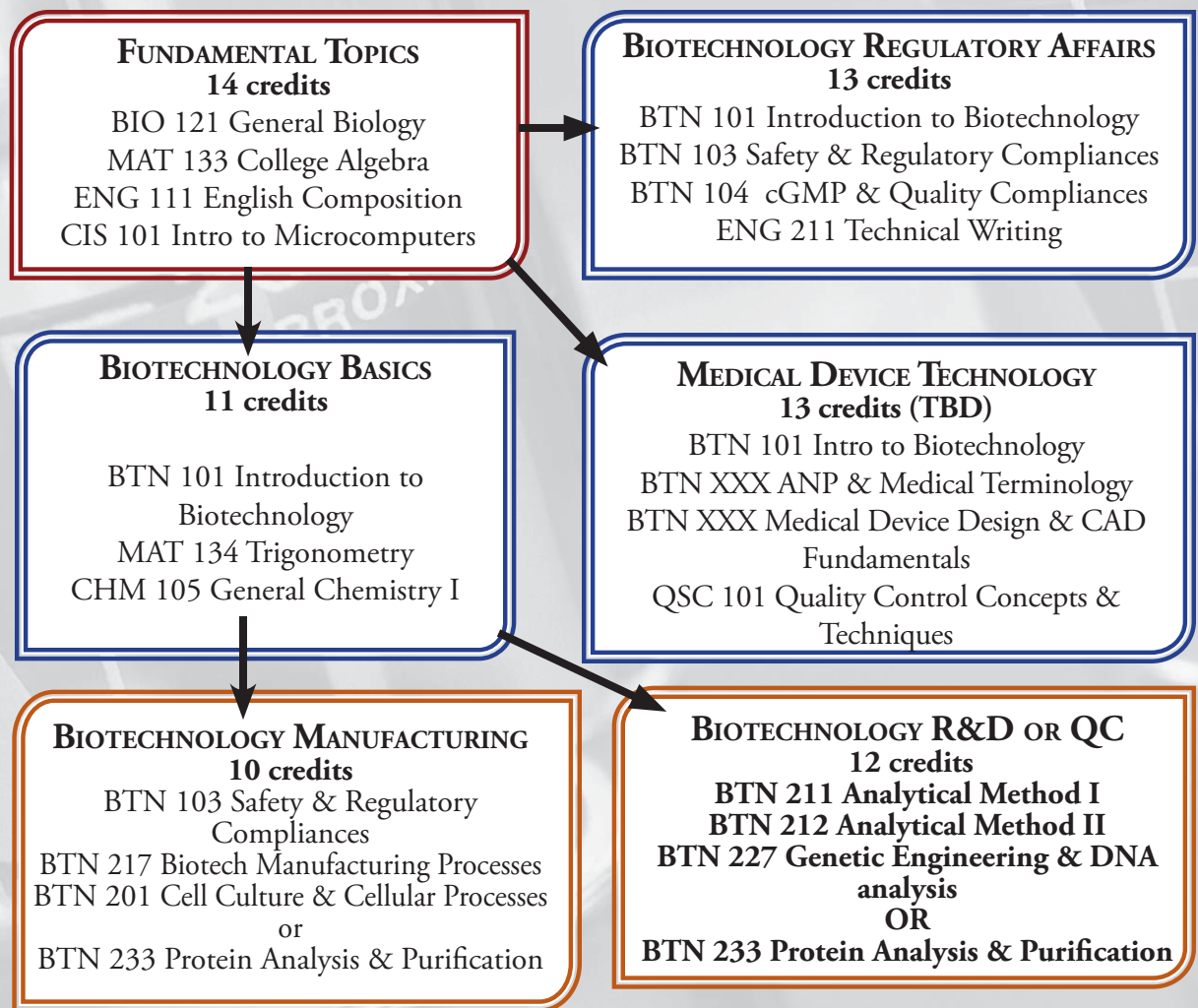


Changing Lives



Biotechnology covers very broad areas that use living organisms or their substances to make beneficial products for humanity. Various natural sciences including cell and molecular biology, microbiology, genetics, physiology, and biochemistry, as well as medicine, engineering, and computer science are interdisciplinary areas of biotechnology. The Hudson Institute projects that Indiana's life sciences/biotechnology industry could create 45,000 jobs over the next five years, with the majority requiring certificates, associates degrees, and bachelors' degrees. Strong demand means attractive salaries.
