Be a Campus Activities Board officer:

Gain Leadership Experience + \$500 Scholarship.

Plan and organize events on behalf of Ivy Tech students as a Campus Activities Board (CAB) officer. As an officer, you will gain leadership experience which can be a valuable addition to your résumé. You will be awarded a \$500 scholarship, each semester, if expectations are met.

Officer activities + involvements:

There are 5 CAB officer positions available. Each officer will lead event planning in a different area:

Student Hospitality and Appreciation

- Create and develop a theme for Welcome Week
- Coordinate arrangements for organized study sessions during finals week
- Coordinate appearances by Chancellor and Administration at various events
- Create and develop a theme for Spring Fling

Family

- Plan cookouts at the start of the Fall semester and end of the Spring semester
- Organize and host a new graduates event with the Alumni Coordinator
- Organize family friendly events which can include bowling nights, movie nights, Ivy Tech Day at the Colts and Pacers, etc.

Culture and Diversity

- Coordinate monthly activities based on nationally recognized monthly themes such as Black History month, Hispanic Heritage month, Women's History month, etc.
- Plan both active and passive opportunities for students such as bulletin boards, dancing, interactive demonstrations, language tables and more!
- Work with Ivy Tech's outreach coordinator on community events

Music and Arts

- Work with the Bloomington community to bring the local music scene to campus
- Host and organize Ivy Tech's Battle of the Bands
- Work with Ivy Tech art and music teachers to bring a diverse variety of artistic works to campus (theatre, musicals, drama etc.)
- Plan a movie series that encourages discussion, thought and fun

Wellness and Recreation

- Recruit and register students for Recreational Sports through city leagues
- Plan and organize tournaments on campus such as ping pong, pool, Euchre, video games, and more!
- Form groups such as walking, yoga, etc.
- Provide opportunities for students to get fitness testing, gym memberships, etc.
- Coordinate wellness activities on campus by inviting Bloomington organizations to Ivy Tech.

All officers:

- Establish, implement and maintain the CAB Web page.
- Serve 10 office hours per week during the spring and fall semesters.
